Super Regional Format Option 1

Super Regional Tournament Format Option 1 Summary:

16 or 20 teams per gender, per classification (depending on equitable entry) will qualify through their District/Combined District Tournament. WIAA Basketball seeding committees will seed the teams prior to the Round/Week 1 of Regionals (no reseeding after rounds).

Rounds 1 and 2 will be single elimination played at local high school or college sites. The higher seeded team will host at the closest local site available. Winners from round 1 will move on to round 2.

The final 4 teams from each classification will move on to the final site after the 2nd round. Semifinal contests will be played on Friday and the winners will move to the championship game played on Saturday. The losers of the semifinal contests will be awarded 3rd place trophies.

2A, 3A and 4A will play semifinals and finals at the Tacoma Dome*. 1B, 2B, 1A will play semifinals and finals at either the Yakima SunDome* or Spokane Veteran's Memorial Arena*
