TICKET PRICES: Tickets can be purchased through any participating school or through Ticketmaster. Tickets will be available for sale at Qwest Field the day of the event. Tickets are good for all of the games and re-entry is permitted. **Gates will open at 8:30am at the northwest corner of the stadium.**

BAG CHECKS: Due to NFL policy, no soft-sided containers, coolers or large bags (bigger than 12"x12"x12") are permitted into Qwest Field. Event security is required to open all bags at the gates for a visual inspection before allowing guests' entry. Security measures may be increased based on orders from the Seattle Police or government as well as the current terror threat level. These procedures will include but are not limited to a more thorough search of persons and property as well as a pat down.

Qwest Field does not allow the following items:

- Alcohol
- Glass bottles or cans
- Illegal drugs
- Firearms/weapons
- Laser pointers
- Horns/whistles/noisemakers
- Any item deemed by management to be inappropriate or may disrupt other fans' enjoyment of the game

GETTING THERE: Please note that the continuing work on the SR-519 project just south of Qwest Field may cause delays. It is strongly recommended that you allow for extra time when planning your trip.

Metro and Sound Transit provide quick and convenient bus and rail service from locations throughout the region:

- **Metro Bus Service:** Over 15 daily bus routes that stop within 3 blocks of Qwest Field – <http://transit.metrokc.gov>
- **ST Express Bus Service:** Sound Transit bus service offers transportation from areas through Pierce, King and Snohomish counties with service every 30 minutes and stops within 3 blocks of Qwest Field – <http://www.soundtransit.org>
- **Link Light Rail:** The Central Link opened in June of 2009 with service from Tukwila to Downtown Seattle. With two stations near Qwest Field, this service is a quick and comfortable way to travel. For details on Light Rail ticket info – <http://www.soundtransit.org>
