**Seeding/Bracket:** All brackets will be 8-man brackets. All wrestlers will be directly seeded into the Regional bracket from Sub-Regionals via trackwrestling.

**Weigh-ins:** Weigh-ins will begin promptly at 8 am in the fitness center/wrestling room. **All wrestlers, including alternates, need to have photo ID.** Weigh-ins will follow National Federation Wrestling rules and will be done by weight on 3 scales. All wrestlers are to be present and remain in the designated weigh-in area during the weigh-in period-this will be strictly followed. During the weigh-in process, no activities that promote hydration or dehydration will be allowed.



**Skin Issues:** Any skin irregularities/disease must be accompanied by a note from a physician stating the disease is non-communicable. A physician's clearance must be on the **STATE APPROVED FORM** and the clearance may not be over a week old.

**Officials:** All officials are assigned by the WIAA.

**Ejection Policy:** Please remind all of your athletes that, as per WIAA guidelines, a participant that is ejected is done for the rest of the tournament and thus the remainder of the season.

- Please inform your students and parents ahead of time so they come prepared to pay admission.
- Only wrestlers in uniform, participating in the tournament, will be admitted free entrance. Wrestlers will be expected to pay if not participating in the tournament.
- Participants, Manager, and Coach Identification Bands will be distributed to coaches in team packets upon arrival. Bands must be worn at all times for tournament access.
- Press passes will be accepted with proper identification. Only those photographers approved by the Tournament Manager will be permitted on the gym floor.
- WIAA "All Access", "Limited Access", and "Lifetime" passes will be accepted.
- Washington State Coaches Association and Washington Secondary School Athletic Administrators Association passes will be accepted.
- LEAGUE PASSES will NOT be accepted.
- Cheerleaders will be permitted for free, only if in uniform.

**\*\*Tournament Passes for the Mat Classic State Tournament will be pre-sold Saturday afternoon.**

**State Qualifiers:** The top four finishers in each weight division will qualify for the State Wrestling Tournament to be held in the Tacoma Dome February 21st & 22<sup>nd</sup>.

The 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place finisher will be the first and second alternate to state. Schools need to bring the first alternate to Tacoma and they will weigh-in and receive a non-floor access pass.

**Awards & Pictures:** Medals will be awarded to the top four wrestlers in each weight class. Awards will be presented following each group of matches in the championship round. Once done with awards, the top four finishers in



each weight class will move to photo area (located in the aux gym) to have their group picture taken for the state program. Per WIAA policy, wrestlers need to be dressed in school warm-ups, which include a top and bottom. Athletes will not be allowed to be in street clothes or have hats, sunglasses, mascots or any other items in the picture with them.

- Locker Rooms:** There will be four locker rooms available to use. Athletes are expected to bring their own towels and to treat the facilities with respect. Please remind your parents and fans that the locker room is off limits and not a public restroom area. Klahowya Secondary School is not responsible for any lost or stolen items and athletes are encouraged to not leave valuables in the locker room area.
- Warm-Up:** Once wrestling starts, there will not be mats available for warm-up.
- Medical Personnel:** If your school is bringing an athletic trainer please put their name on the pass list. Klahowya Secondary School will have a Certified Athletic Trainer available. A doctor will be provided to conduct skin checks at the weigh-in. Be sure to have your Skin Sheets at the weigh-in.
- Blood Clean Up:** Klahowya Secondary School will provide individuals to clean the mats. Coaches need to clean their own wrestlers.
- Parking:** Parking is available in the parking. See the attached mat (at the back of this syllabus).
- Signs:** No signs are allowed in the gym area except for official school banners.
- Hospitality Room:** There will be a hospitality room for coaches, officials, school administrators, and tournament workers. No students will be allowed in the hospitality room and please remember to clean up after yourself.
- Concessions:** The Klahowya Wrestling Booster Club will be on hand all day selling food and drinks.
- Bands & Noisemakers:** No bands or noisemakers of any type are allowed in the gym.
- Tournament Apparel:** Team Apparel will be available on-site, being sold by Rush Apparel.
