WEIGH IN PROCEDURE

Scales will be open at 8:15 am to check weight. Reminder, NFHS rule 4.4.3 prohibits methods intended to promote quick weight loss "At any time...", and could result in disqualification.

Weight classes will be called individually, beginning with 106.

Weigh in – 9:00 am, Bonney Lake HS Upper Gym.

Wrestlers must have photo ID, either a driver's license or school ID photo, at the time of weigh-in

Please see attached Regional Weigh-in process. All requirements must be followed.

COACHES MEETING

Saturday, February 15.

9:30 AM or immediately following the completion of weigh-ins, located in the Bonney Lake High School Hospitality Room.

Head Coaches Only, Officials, Meet Director and Tournament medical staff.

Coaching Packets will be handed out as you enter the gym lobby through Pass Gate.

WSWCA business can be conducted following the tournament procedure meeting.

PASSES

No league passes will be honored – Acceptable passes are posted at the site and attached

Athletic Director/Coaches are to complete and e-mail the included participation list. Support personnel are considered to be: coaches, manager/statistician, trainer, and up to two school supervisors. This list must be emailed no later than **Thursday, February 13, 2020.**

Cheer staff in uniform will be admitted free. Cheer advisors arriving with the cheer squad will be admitted free. Cheer squads will be limited to 4 per mat during all pre-final bouts and up to 8 per mat for finals.

AWARDS

Medals will be awarded to the top 4 place finishers. The top 4 finishers must have school approved warm-up tops and bottoms on during the award presentation and State Program photo. Awards and State photos will be done immediately after the final match in each weight class. We will not wait until the end of the finals round to award the medals. The coach of the Region I Champion wrestler will be asked to assist with the award presentation. Team scores will be kept but there is no team award given during this first round of the state tournament (Regional tournament).

STATE QUALIFIERS

Top 4 finishers in each weight division will qualify for the State "Mat Classic XXXII" Wrestling Tournament to be held at the Tacoma Dome, February 21 & 22, 2020. The 5th place finisher in each weight class will be named the alternate for any Region I scratches for that weight class.

OFFICIALS

Officials are assigned by the WIAA. Two officials per mat will be used for the consolation finals, state alternate match and championship finals.

MATCHES ENDING IN A DRAW

National Federation Rules for overtime matches apply.

TRAINERS/FIRST AID

Two certified Athletic Trainers from ATI will be present and will serve as official event medical authority. A licensed physician may be on call if available.

PROTESTS

Protests occurring at the tournament will be presented to the tournament manager and he will confer with the games committee (minimum of 3 representatives) provided the correct WIAA protest procedure has been followed. The decision of the committee will be final.

MEET PROCEDURES

The National Anthem will open the Tournament, just before the start of Round 1.

FLOOR RESTRICTIONS

Only wrestlers, coaches, officials and designated school staff are permitted in the lower main floor area. Non-wrestlers that are permitted in the lower main gym floor area must wear the provided wrist band to be allowed entrance into the lower gym. All others are restricted to the upstairs viewing area and the gym lobby.

Match check-in process

Weight classes, wrestlers and mat assignments will be called by PA and can be identified on the Trackwrestling projection screen in the main gym. Wrestlers who are "on deck" should report to their assigned mat and will check in at their mat scorer table when the previous match concludes. All other wrestlers should remain in the stands.

Only **two** support staff are allowed mat side during their participant's bout – they may be head coaches, assistant coaches, trainers or managers. Two mat side chairs will be provided.

DRESSING ROOMS

While using the locker/dressing rooms, wrestlers will continuously keep the area clean by depositing debris in waste cans, by not tamper with PE baskets and will leave bulletin boards alone. Locker rooms will not be locked, so personal items should not be left unattended.

MEDIA

Only pre-approved media will be given a mat pass and authorized mat side privileges. Pre-Approval is available via the WIAA website and must be presented when checking in at the pass gate. There will be **NO** main gym or mat side privileges for school photographers or team photographers. All video and photographs should be taken from the upper gym spectator area.

SIGNS

As per league and WIAA rule, no signs will be allowed except for the official school banner.

BANDS / NOISE MAKERS

No bands are allowed. Artificial noise makers are **NOT** allowed and may be confiscated by tournament personnel.

HOSPITALITY

A hospitality room will be provided by the Bonney Lake High School wrestling booster club. Access to the hospitality room will be reserved for coaches, designated staff and officials, and you must be wearing tournament access wristbands.

SCORING

Individual placement points shall be awarded as soon as earned. Placement points already earned shall be deducted in case of forfeit (other than injury) or disqualification from the tournament. Points for team scoring shall be awarded as follows: 1st pl – 16, 2nd pl – 12, 3rd pl – 9, 4th pl – 7, 5th pl – 5, 6th pl – 3

- 2 team advancement points shall be scored for each match won in the championship bracket, except for the 1st-place match. 1 team advancement point for each match won in the consolation round, except the 3rd/4th and 5th place matches. A wrestler who receives a bye shall be awarded advancement points by winning the next match. No points are awarded for the bye if the wrestler loses the next match.
- 2 additional points shall be scored for each match won by default, disqualification, fall or forfeit.
- 1 ½ additional points shall be scored for each match won by technical fall
- One additional point shall be awarded for each match won by a major decision.
- In tournaments scoring six places, the winner of each championship quarterfinal shall be awarded 3 place points, the winner of each championship semifinal shall be awarded 9 additional points and the winner of each championship final shall be awarded 4 additional place points. The winner of the quarterfinal consolation match shall receive 3 place points. The winner of the consolation semifinals shall receive 4 additional place points. The winner of 3rd place and the winner of 5th place shall receive 2 additional place points.

DIRECTIONS TO BONNEY LAKE HIGH SCHOOL

- **From HWY 167 (North or Southbound)**
 - Take the Highway 410, Sumner/Yakima exit eastbound
 - Follow Hwy 410 up the hill into Bonney Lake
 - At the fifth (5th) traffic light on Hwy 410, turn right onto South Prairie Road
 - At the first traffic light on South Prairie, turn right onto 199th
 - At the first traffic light on 199th, turn right onto 104th
 - School is just past the Maintenance/Transportation Center on the left
 - Fan parking entry – first driveway past the reader board on the left
 - Team drop-off entry – second driveway past the reader board on the left

PARKING

Athlete drop off is in front of the main gym, next to the Performing Arts Center. Team buses and vans are **NOT** allowed to park in the area directly in front of the gym or in the main lower lot. Buses and vans should proceed around the back of the gym after drop off, and park in the upper lot next to the baseball and fastpitch fields and tennis courts.

Fans can park in the lower main lot, the stalls in front of the gym or in the upper lot.
PARK in designated stalls only.

DO NOT park in any area labeled as No Parking, areas that are coned off or in the loop area around the rock in front of the Performing Arts Center. Emergency vehicle access must be available at all times.

OVERSIZED vehicles shall not park in the area surrounding the main gym. Oversized vehicles will park in the lower or upper parking lots on campus. The parking area in front of or behind the gym is not to be used by oversized vehicles, buses, or vans.

WIAA REGIONAL TOURNAMENT WEIGH-IN PROCEDURES

WEIGH-IN WILL PROGRESS MOST SMOOTHLY IF EACH COACH FAMILIARIZES HIS WRESTLERS WITH THE FOLLOWING PROCEDURES PRIOR TO WEIGH-IN.

- A. All weigh-ins will start at 9:00 am, 2 hours prior to the start of wrestling each day of the tournament. We will weigh in by weight class, starting with 106, however **ALL** wrestlers from **ALL** weight classes must report and remain in the designated weigh-in area during the weigh-in period. No one will be allowed to enter the weigh-in area after the weigh-in process has begun. No one will be allowed to leave the weigh-in area until the weigh-in process has completed and the tournament director releases the participants. Once **ALL** weight classes have completed their weigh-in process, then the wrestlers and coaches will be allowed to leave the weigh-in area and the weigh-in process will be considered complete.
- B. **The wrestlers and coach will gather in the upper gym, behind the spectator bleachers. Coaches will have their weigh-in sheets provided in their Coaches Packets. The coach must take this sheet to the scales area. THE WRESTLER MUST PRESENT PHOTO ID SUCH AS AN ASB CARD OR DRIVER'S LICENSE as he is checked by the official.**

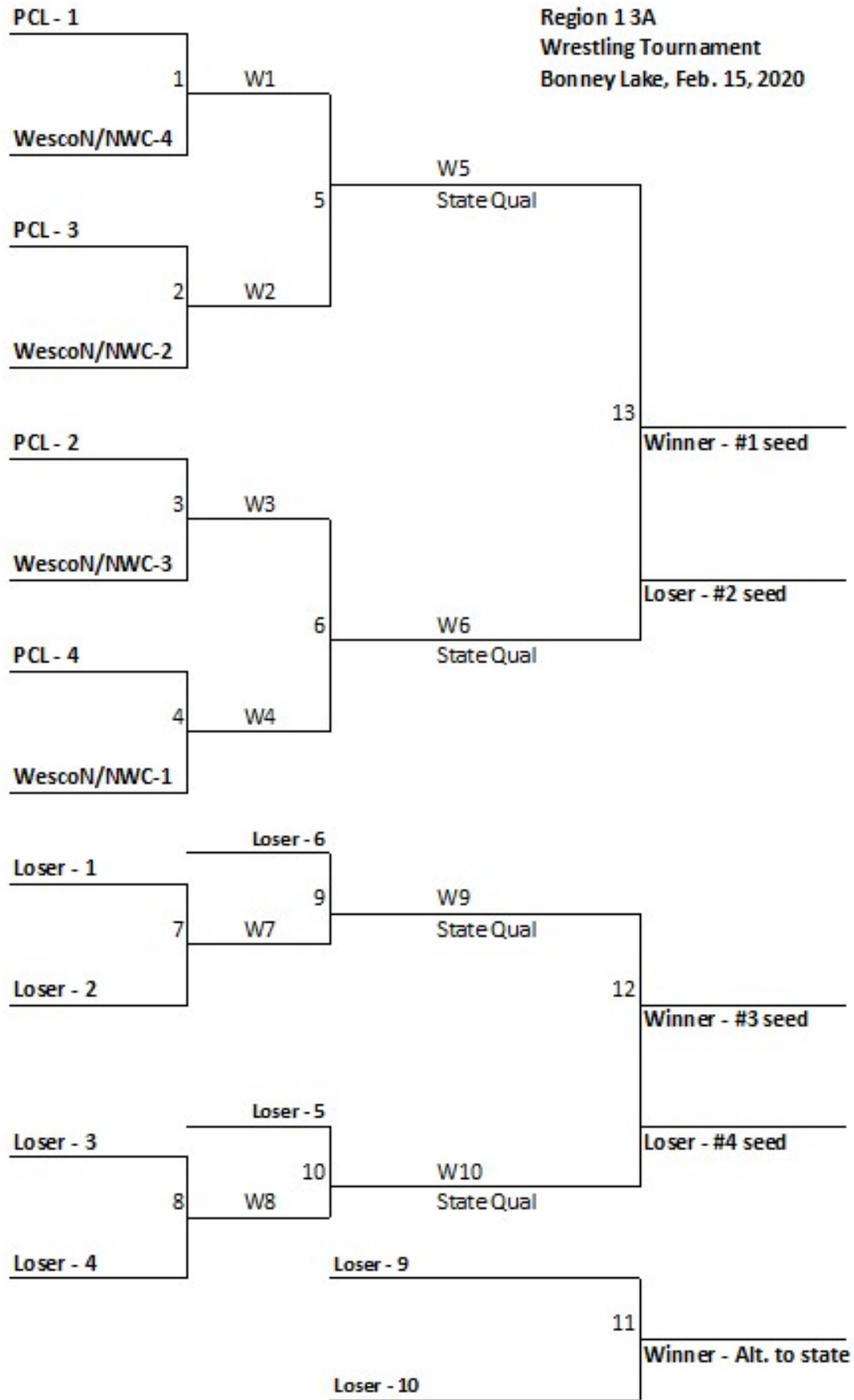
There are to be **NO** attempts at dehydration while in the weigh-in area.

- C. Each weight class will be called, one at a time, starting with the lowest weight class for the tournament. All eligible wrestlers, including alternates, must weigh in at the time of their respective weight class. There will be last calls for each weight class before moving to the next weight.
- D. Wrestlers treated by a Physician prior to the tournament, must bring the Infectious Skin Form, signed by the physician, to weigh-ins. This form is only good for 10 days from date of signature. The tournament Official/Physician/Trainer will have final determination on the participation of all wrestlers concerning health and safety issues.
- E. The coach shall use the weigh-in sheet provided to record the official weight for his/her wrestlers. **Only wrestlers whose weight is approved by the official will become tournament entrants.**
- F. A wrestler shall weigh-in for only one weight class during the weigh-in period. If only one scale is available, a wrestler may step on and off that scale TWO times to allow for mechanical inconsistencies in the scale. If multiple scales are available, a wrestler may step on and off the first scale TWO times to allow for mechanical inconsistencies in that scale. If the wrestler fails to make weight on the first scale, the wrestler shall immediately step on each of the available scales ONE time in an attempt to make weight.
- G. The weigh-in session ends once all weight classes have been completed and the tournament director releases the coaches and athletes.

ALTERNATE REGISTRATION AND WEIGH-IN PROCEDURES

- A. Every effort will be made to notify coaches in the event their alternate(s) seems likely to become a contestant. However, it is always best to check personally with coaches from within your league.
- B. Alternates will weigh-in during their weight class timeframe.
- C. Alternates become entrants **only** when a wrestler **from within the alternate's own league/district** is unable to compete due to illness, injury, failure to make weight or expulsion (at league/districts); provided the first tournament bout has not begun.
